49. TEDDINGTON CPZ REVIEW

The Cabinet Member agreed to the:

- continued operation of the Teddington CPZ;
- formal advertisement of a number of minor operational amendments inside and outside the Teddington CPZ boundary in respect of parking areas, waiting restrictions and other minor measures as set out in the report;
- formal advertisement of an extension to the CPZ in the remaining uncontrolled parts of Clarence Road.

[The Cabinet Member was requested:

- to investigate the re-instatement of white lines across private driveways with the aim of deterring unauthorised parking;
- to, as part of a future review, investigate ways in which to increase parking for residents in streets (particularly Christchurch Road) during non-operational hours of the CPZ.

The Committee heard representations from Mr Holder, Mr Howland, Mrs Sankey, Dr Van Stigt. Councillor Mumford spoke as a ward Councillor.]
